

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MATACHEWAN

BY-LAW NUMBER 2007-16

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE CANADA ONTARIO MUNICIPAL AND RURAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM (“COMRIF”) FOR THE ASSET MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FUNDING BETWEEN THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MATACHEWAN (THE “MUNICIPALITY”) AND THE ONTARIO MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE, FOOD AND RURAL AFFAIRS (OMAFRA); AND TO APPROVE THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS ON SAID ELIGIBLE PROJECTS;

WHEREAS, the *Municipal Act, 2001* (Ontario), as amended, (the “Act”) provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

AND WHEREAS, the Province of Ontario requires that every municipality in Ontario has a program in place by January of 2008 for the management of all capital assets;

AND WHEREAS, OMAFRA has determined that the municipality is an eligible Ontario municipality desirous of obtaining funding pursuant to the COMRIF program in connection with the Asset Management Program;

AND WHEREAS the eligible Municipality has submitted an Application to COMRIF to request funding;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MATACHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (a) The Council of the Municipality hereby confirms, ratifies and approves the completion by the CAO-Clerk-Treasurer of an Application and the submission by such authorized official of an Application, duly executed by such authorized official, to COMRIF for the aforementioned funding;
- (b) Any one or more of the Deputy Reeve and the CAO-Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized to conclude contracts on behalf of the Municipality for the Project(s) in accordance with the Municipality’s usual protocol;

This By-law takes effect on the day of passing.
