

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MATACHEWAN

BY-LAW NO. 2009-17

Being a by-law to name certain municipal roadways and streets in the Township of Matachewan, District of Timiskaming.

WHEREAS Section 47 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 provides that the Council of a municipality may pass by-laws for giving the names of roadways.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 6(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, the municipality, may by by-law authorize the acquisition of lands for the purposes of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Matachewan wishes to authorize the acquisition of and ownership of certain lands adjoining existing allowances for roadways and/or highways for the purpose of naming them;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Matachewan enacts as follows:

1. That the name of the street shown on Plan M-157-T registered in the Registry Office for the Land Titles Division as Front Street, be and the same, is hereby renamed to be Rye Street. Furthermore, said street is hereby assumed by the municipality as a roadway for seasonal public use as part of the municipal road system.
2. That the name of the road located off of the Queens Highway Number 566 west of the Townsite of Matachewan commonly known as Johnnie George Road, be and the same, is hereby confirmed to be John George Road.
3. The signing officers of the Corporation of the Township of Matachewan are hereby authorized and directed to do all things and execute all such documents as may be required in that regard.
4. That all previous by-laws and/or motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with or contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
5. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect upon its final passing thereof and remain in force and effect.
