He will be sadly missed by all who knew him.



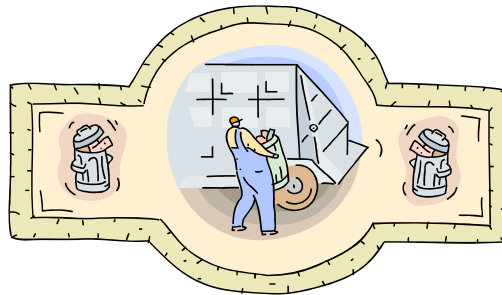

MUNICIPAL ALERT!

PROPERTY CLEAN-UP NOW BEING FULLY ENFORCED!



Therefore it is highly recommend that all property owners currently not in compliance with By-Law 2008-22, Clean Yards, take full advantage of the 2010 FREE Spring Clean-up Weekend May 15th & 16th.

Properties must be drained and clear of all garbage, waste material, refuse or domestic or industrial waste of any kind.

The following list contains examples of articles that are not permitted;

- Dead/decayed/damaged trees or any other articles that pose a safety risk to surrounding environment.
- Any articles that allows for free standing or stagnant water
- Unused Appliances
- Swimming pools, hot tubs, wading pools or artificial ponds that are not in good working condition
- Compost not in accordance to by-law specifications
- Inoperative motor vehicles (damaged/deteriorated/unlicensed or uninsured vehicles of any type or class. No more than one hobby vehicle is permitted
- Unruly, untidy or ungroomed landscaping, including excessive weed and grass longer than 15 cm
- Unused or spare parts fittings, pipes/mechanical remnants/ vehicle parts/ tires/ mechanical equipment/ mechanical parts/accessories or adjuncts to motor vehicles, mechanical equipment and things of the like
- Paper, cartons, fabrics or carpets
- Furniture
- Crockery
- Sewage
- Industrial waste of any kind
- Containers or pallets of any type or compensation
- Agricultural, animal, vegetable, paper, lumber or wood products
- Mineral, metal or chemical products
- Animal carcasses, bones, feathers or hides
- Rubble, inert fill except loose soil, sand or gravel
- Piping, tubing, conduits, cable and fittings or other accessories, or adjuncts of the like
- Any items that are neglected, damaged, discarded or in a deteriorative state
- Waste Disposal, dumping or burying of waste
- Unsafe buildings or structures

SPRING CLEAN-UP, SPECIAL WASTE ARTICLES LIST: If you have a waste articles that cannot be safely placed on the side of municipal streets, such as an inoperable vehicles or excessive or large items, contact the municipal office to have the item added to the "Spring Clean-up Special Waste Articles" list to be removed by machinery at no cost to you. Some restrictions apply.

NOTICE: The Municipal By-Law Control Officer has the "Right of Entry" onto any property for the purpose of inspection. However, your cooperation is appreciated.

GARBAGE MUST BE SEPARATED:

- (1) Clean/burnable wood
- (2) regular household waste
- (3) metal
