## Notice of the Passage of By-Laws

TAKE NOTICE THAT pursuant to Section 251 of the Ontario Municipal Act, 2001 and the Township of Matachewan Notice By-Law 2005-12, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Matachewan at its meeting to be held on Monday, June 19, 2006 proposes to pass the following By-Laws:

1. **BY-LAW 2006-12**, BEING A BY-LAW FOR ESTABLISHING TAX RATIOS FOR 2006.
2. **BY-LAW 2006-13**, BEING A BY-LAW FOR ESTABLISHING THE PERCENTAGES BY WHICH TAX DECREASES ARE LIMITED FOR 2006.
3. **BY-LAW 2006-14**, BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE 2006 MUNICIPAL BUDGET AND TAX RATES AND TO FURTHER PROVIDE FOR PENALTY AND INTEREST IN DEFAULT OF PAYMENT THEREOF FOR 2006.

The Corporation of the Township of Matachewan hereby gives public notice of its intent to pass these by-laws at our regular public council meeting on Monday, June 19, 2006 at 6:00 pm at the Matachewan Community Hall. Anyone may attend the meeting outlined above to make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to the proposed by-laws. 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**THE ONTARIO CLEAN WATER AGENCY (OCWA) WILL BE CONDUCTING WATERMAIN FLUSHING ON SATURDAY JUNE 3<sup>RD</sup> BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00 A.M. AND 2:00 P.M.**

This work is necessary in order to remove sediment, rust and other matter from our water distribution system. Should discolouration of water occur, please let your tap run until the water becomes clear. The Township of Matachewan wishes to apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause.

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Saturday, **June 3<sup>rd</sup>** 2006 has been designated as **Spring Clean-up Day** here in Matachewan. As in previous years, residents may place large items (that they would normally not be capable of bringing to the landfill site with ease) on the roadside for pick-up. In order to keep our streets clean, we ask that all items be **PLACED NOT DUMPED** on the roadside the day prior. Debris placed on the roadside after the scheduled date will not be picked up. There will be no pick-up in the lanes. The **Property Standards By-law # 97-04**, which prescribes standards for the maintenance of and clearing of all structures, debris or refuse, **will be strictly enforced** henceforth. Therefore, now is your opportunity to clean up the treasures on your property and get rid of those old cars rotting in your back yard at no additional cost to you. Your co-operation is appreciated!
