## Ontario's New Blue Box System



#### Starting January 1, 2026, Ontario will transition to an enhanced recycling system

Ontarians will be able to recycle the same materials at the curb no matter where they are across the province, and be able to recycle more materials than ever before! This new system follows Ontario's two and a half year transition to an extended producer responsibility (EPR) framework for blue box materials.

#### **About Ontario's transition to EPR**

- In 2021, the Ontario government released the Blue Box Regulation that shifts the financial and operational responsibility of recycling programs to producers – those that supply blue box materials to residents
- As the administrator of Ontario's common collection system, Circular Materials is responsible for operating the new system for blue box materials.
- Circular Materials is committed to ensuring more materials are looped into the circular economy, benefiting both people and the environment.



#### **About Circular Materials**

<u>Circular Materials</u> is the administrator of Ontario's common collection system and a national not-for-profit organization building efficient and effective recycling systems where materials are collected, recycled, and returned back to producers to use as recycled content in new packaging and products.
