## BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT A CHIEF BUILDING OFFICIAL AND A BUILDING INSPECTOR

WHEREAS Subsection 3 (2) of the <u>Building Code Act</u>, S.O. 1992, c. 23, as amended, requires the Council to appoint a chief building official,

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Matachewan has entered into a joint enforcement agreement pursuant to Subsection 3 (3) of the <u>Building Code Act</u>,

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Matachewan deems it necessary and expedient to appoint a chief building official for the purposes of the enforcement of the <u>Building Code Act</u> and the provisions of the building code in the areas in which the municipality has jurisdiction.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Matachewan enacts as follows:

- 1- That **Francis Rivard** is hereby appointed Chief Building Official and **Arren Hearn** is hereby appointed Building Inspector for the Corporation of the Township of Matachewan, and
- 2- That the Chief Building Official and Building Inspector or their alternate shall be responsible for the enforcement of the <u>Building Code Act</u>, S.O. 1992, c.23, as amended, and the provisions of the Building Code in the areas in which **Francis Rivard** has qualifications under Clause 2.16.2.1.(1)(b) of the Building Code, except the provisions of Part 8 Sewage Systems which are enforced by another principal authority pursuant to Section 3.1 <u>Building Code Act</u> and Section 2.15. of the building code, and
- 3- That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its final passing.
- 4- That all By-laws and resolutions, or parts thereof, contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

**READ** a first and second and third time, and finally enacted and passed in open Council this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March, 2017. Signed, sealed and numbered 2017-08.
