

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MATACHEWAN

BY-LAW 2013-05

Being a by-law to name certain municipal roadways and streets in the Township of Matachewan, District of Timiskaming.

WHEREAS section 47 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 provides that the Council of a municipality may pass by-laws for giving the names of the roadways.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 6(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, the municipality may by by-law authorize the acquisition of lands for the purposes of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Matachewan wishes to authorize the acquisition of and ownership of certain lands adjoining allowances for roadways and/or highways for the purpose of naming them;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Matachewan enacts as follows:

1. That the name of the street being PIN 61399 0106, 61399 0098, 61400 0017, 61400 0350, west part of 61400 0341, MR-6582, MR-6252, Plan M277T, Plan M157T, Plan M117T, Concession A, Lot 12, Township of Cairo, Matachewan, Ontario, registered in the Registry Office for the Land Titles Division as Front Street, be and the same, is hereby renamed to be Rye Street. Furthermore, said street is hereby assumed by the municipality as a roadway for seasonal public use as part of the municipal road system.
2. The signing officers of the Corporation of the Township of Matachewan are hereby authorized and directed to do all things and execute all such documents as may be required in that regard.
3. That all previous by-laws and/or motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with, or contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
4. That this by-law shall come into force and effect upon its final passing thereof and remain in force and effect.
