The Township of Matachewan Public Works is declaring a Significant Weather Event under the provisions of the Minimum Maintenance Standards for Municipal Highways, O.Reg 239/02, Starting Friday afternoon into Monday.

Due to the special weather statement issued by Environment Canada and forecasted major winter storm with heavy snowfall and risk of freezing rain beginning Friday afternoon and continuing through Monday.

Delays are expected in all areas of town with the plowing of municipal roads, streets, walkways and municipal facilities parking lots. Public Works resources will be deployed as conditions allow.

Special Weather Statement in effect for:

- Kirkland Lake - Englehart

Significant snowfall possible this afternoon and tonight. Another winter storm possible on Sunday.


What:
Snowfall accumulations of 5 to 10 cm today. Additional precipitation likely on Sunday.
Reduced visibility in areas of heavier snow.
Difficult travel conditions and possible road closures.

When:
Beginning this afternoon and ending early Saturday morning. Second weather system to affect the area Sunday.

Additional information:
Snow is expected to begin this afternoon, intensifying this evening. At this point, the heaviest snowfall will likely remain south of the region, although amounts up to 10 cm are still possible. Snow will taper off by Saturday morning.

After a brief break Saturday, another winter storm will likely affect the region on Sunday with a threat of significant snowfall, freezing rain and ice pellets. More details on precipitation amounts will come in future updates.
