#### **BY-LAW NO. 2025-15**

BEING A BY-LAW TO ENABLE THE MUNICIPALITY TO COLLECT USER FEES FROM USERS OF ITS MUNICIPAL FACILITIES AND SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, C.25, Section 391, allows municipalities to pass a by-law to set user fees to recover costs for providing certain services or facilities;

**AND WHEREAS**, the Council of the municipality deems it expedient to pass a bylaw to adopt rates for users of its facilities or services;

NOW THEREFORE, the Township of Matachewan enacts as follows:

- 1) That the user fee schedules A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, and K attached hereto are declared to be and form part of this by-law.
- 2) That these schedules of fees be used for the rates charged to users of facilities and services. All fees are payable in Canadian Dollars only.
- 3) Failure to remit applicable fees will result in the addition of interest/penalty charges. Unpaid arrears may be added to property tax invoices and all charges herein shall survive ratepayers and their estates.
- 4) That all previous by-laws and/or motions in conflict herewith, establishing user fees and/or rates are hereby repealed.
- 5) That this by-law shall come into force and effect upon final passing thereof and remain in force and effect until such time as it is repealed by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Matachewan.

All arrears for water will be charged a 5% per month penalty. All arrears owing as at December 31st of any given year will be added to the tax roll on January 1st of the following year and collected in the same manner as taxes.

As per By-Law 2009-12(9)(a) Owners will fill out an application at the Municipal Office for a new water connection and a fee of \$1,200.00 will be charged and collected.

No water turn-on or off will be permitted after October 31 or prior to April 30 in any year. This stipulation is notwithstanding an emergency situation. Any turn-on or off during this period is subject to significant additional labour, equipment and material costs, the entirety of which is the responsibility of the property owner. All applicable fees must be remitted and documentation must be completed prior to servicing. One turn on and one turn off will be permitted at no charge per annum for seasonal users only, provided it is during regular office hours and before October 31 and after April 30 in any given year, otherwise the standard fees will still apply.

#### **LANDFILL SITE RATES**

All loads will be inspected by the landfill attendant before any dumping will be permitted. This landfill site is operated by the Township of Matachewan and is exclusively for the use of ratepayers of Powell, Cairo, Midlothian, Doon, Yarrow and Kimberley Townships who obtain an eligible Landfill Access Pass. Use of this private property by other than the above constitutes trespassing.

As per Resolution 06-143, all costs (including burial [equipment/operator rentals of \$140.00 per hour] and staff overtime of \$24.00 per hour) are to be paid by the landfill user. All waste dumped at the landfill site is subject to the provisions of the Certificate of Approval and Ministry of Environment regulations in addition to the municipal landfill procedures and best practices. Products utilizing Freon, propane or any other gas/fuel must be certified as empty.

In addition to applicable fees, non-compliance will result in a minimum charge of \$50.00 plus costs for a first occurrence, \$100.00 plus costs for a second occurrence and \$200.00 plus costs, plus loss of landfill privileges for a third infraction.

#### Obtaining a Landfill Vehicle Access Pass

Ratepayers must obtain a Pass from the Matachewan Town Office. Proof of registration, driver's license (or other valid identification), proof of address, year, make and model of the vehicle, and license plate number are required. The registrant must be present to sign for the pass. Maximum of 2 passes per household or business. Passes must be visible, displayed or presented to the landfill attendant for his/her logs.

#### Tipping Fee Vouchers\*\*

Residents and non-residents must obtain vouchers at the Matachewan Town Office. Vouchers are payable in advance and are to be given to the landfill attendant at the time of use.

#### Buck-A-Bag

Non-residents must purchase \$1.00 per bag stickers at the Town Office.

- Fees will be rounded to the nearest dollar.
- Conditional and partial permits will be calculated at the regular rate for the complete project.
- No permit shall be less than \$90.00 minimum.

#### **Refunds**

- 1. No refund shall be given for an application fee, or fees for a conditional, change of use or partial permit.
- 2. No refund shall be given for permits or inspections valued at \$100 or less.
- 3. Where a permit fee has been paid pursuant to this By-law, fees may be refunded based on the following formula and to Section 6.1 of this By-law:

#### Construction or Demolition Permit

- 80% where the application is withdrawn or only administrative functions have been performed;
- ii) 50% if administrative, applicable law compliance and plans examination functions have been performed;
- iii) 25% if the permit has been issued and the application is withdrawn or construction does not commence, or no field inspections have been carried out
- iv) No refunds if field inspections have been carried out.
